



- Grant officially received: January 29, 2010






# Targeted Industries


- The energy-efficient building, construction, and retrofit industries;



## Planned Program Outcomes by Partner Type


Type / Outcomes / Percent

## Planned Program Outcomes by Sector



## Vermont:

- First state to adopt a full system of renewable energy feed-in tariffs
- By the end of 2012 will be the first state with a border to border smart grid
- Has established “clean energy assessment districts” to ease renewable energy/efficiency project creation in homes & businesses

- In March 2008, Vermont adopted a renewable energy goal to produce 25 percent of the energy consumed in the State from renewable sources, in particular from the State's farms and forests, by 2025.
  - Vermont is among the top “greenest” states for its energy efficiency policy and standards, energy production, research and development, and financial information and incentives.


